

Multiple Uses for Dryer Sheets

Did you know all these wonderful things a dryer sheet can do?

- Repel mosquitoes. Tie a dryer sheet through a belt loop and outdoors during mosquito season
- Eliminate static electricity on TV screen. Wipe screen with a used sheet to keep dust off
- Dissolve soap scum from shower doors
- Freshen air in your home. Place an individual sheet in a drawer or hang in closet
- Prevent thread from tangling. Run a threaded needle through a sheet before sewing
- Eliminate static cling from pantyhose. Rub a damp, used sheet over the hose
- Prevent musty suitcases. Place a sheet inside empty suitcase before storing it
- Car air freshener. Place a sheet under the front seat
- Avoid static electricity shock. Place a sheet in your coat pocket in winter to avoid shock when you get in the car
- Clean baked on food from cooking pan. Place a sheet in the pan, fill with water, let sit overnight and sponge clean. The antistatic agents apparently weaken the bond between the food and the pan, while the softening agents soften the baked on food.
- Eliminate odors in wastebaskets. Place a sheet in the bottom of the basket
- Collect cat hair. Rubbing the area with a sheet will magnetically attract the loose hairs.
- Eliminate static electricity from venetian blinds. Wipe blinds with a sheet to prevent dust from settling
- Wipe up sawdust from drilling or sandpapering. A used sheet will attract sawdust like a tack cloth
- Eliminate odors in dirty laundry. Place a sheet at the bottom of laundry bag or hamper
- Deodorize sneakers or shoes. Place in shoe overnight so they smell good in the morning
- Another thing you can do is hang a sheet outside your doors to keep the flies from congregating there and flying inside every time the door is opened. Place them in a work shed that has no air-conditioning and you will prevent flies from coming in.
